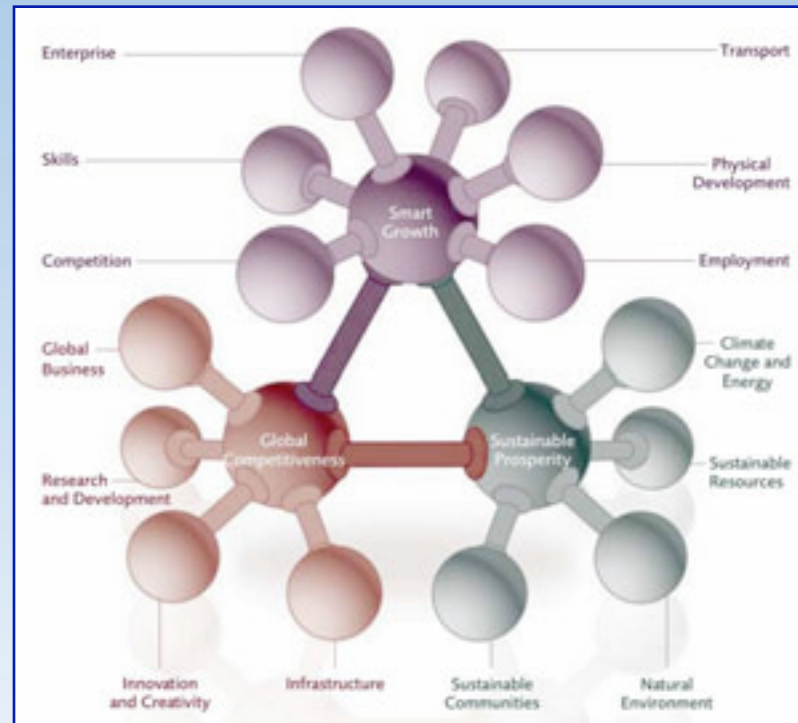
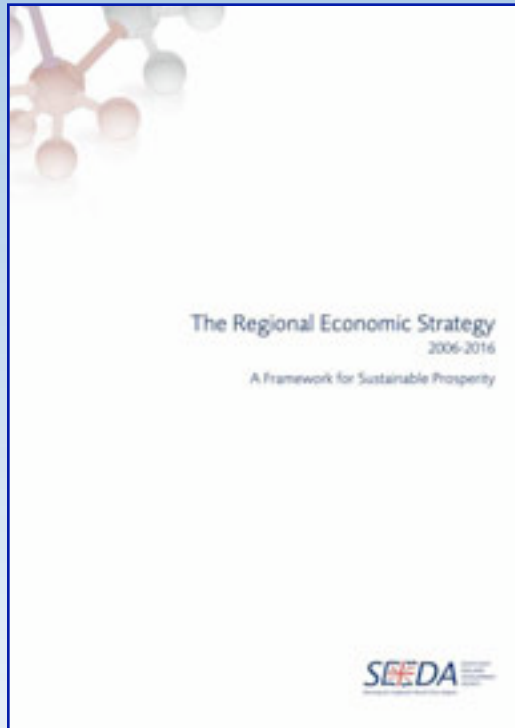


# What is SEEDA ?

- Development of the Regional Economic Strategy – RES

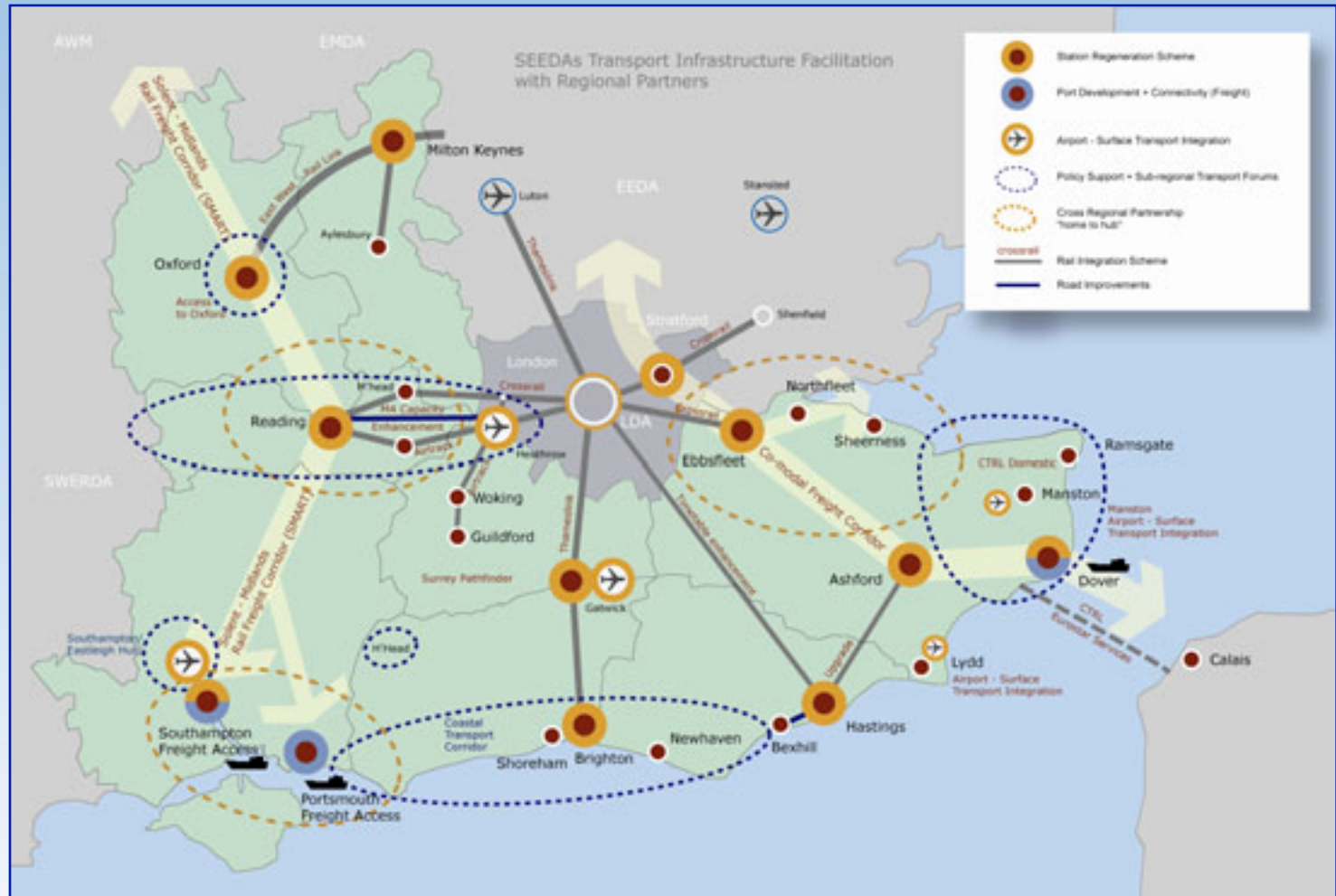

### Investment:

€ 3.000.000 into the Fastrack transit system being constructed to serve the new High Speed Train station at Ebbsfleet and deprived communities along the Thames Estuary

### Investment:

€ 895,000 to help Ashford realise its potential as a business gateway between Britain and the rest of Europe.

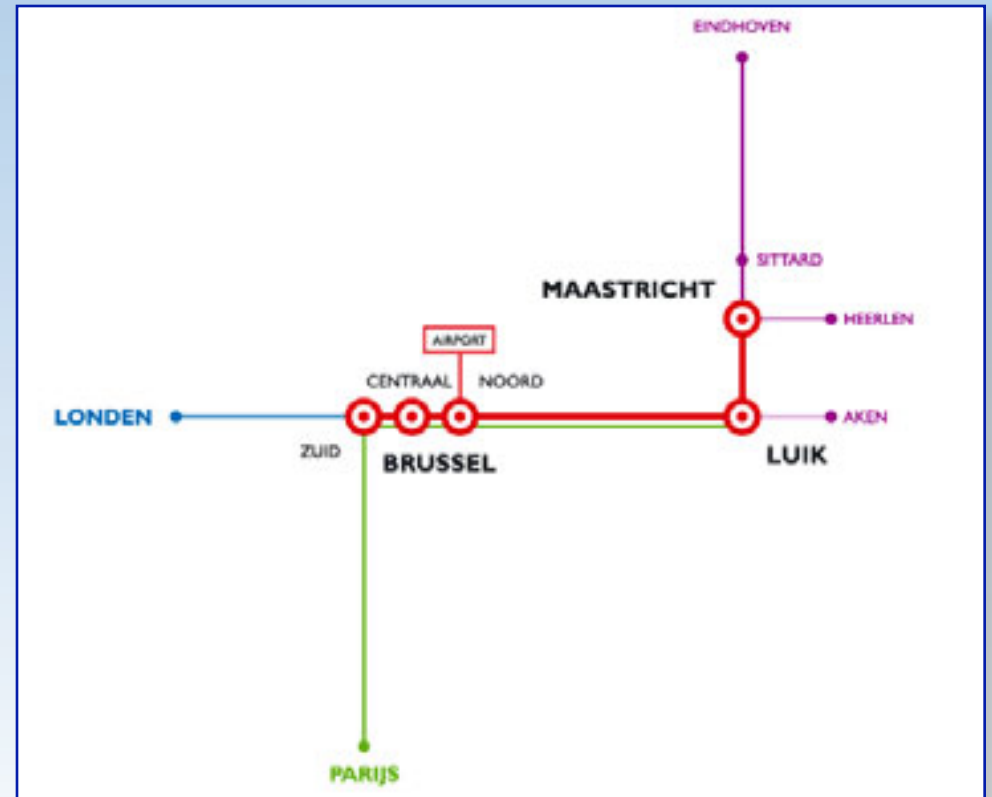

## European Match-funding to deliver regional transport

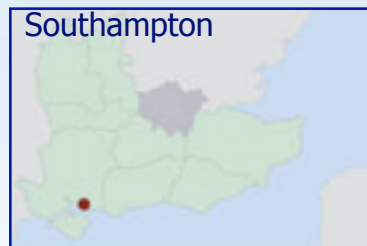


Portsmouth (48%):
